The CPH 90 brings classic desk aesthetics into a modern context. The Bouroullec brothers' simple yet graceful asymmetrical legs coupled with the streamlined tabletop results in a functional, compact and uncluttered design. The Copenhagen Desk is suited to most commercial or educational environments, as well as being ideal for working at home. The frame is in solid oak and the plywood tabletop comes in a variety of wood or linoleum options.

PRODUCT DETAILS

- / Multi-functional family of tables in different shapes, sizes, materials and colours.
- / Variability of veneer, laminate and linoleum colours and frame finishes.
- / The table is available as a round table with three legs (CPH 20), a round table with four legs (CPH 25), a rectangular table (CPH 30) and office desks (CPH 10, CPH 190).

MATERIAL

TABLETOP / 18 mm plywood tabletop with laminate, linoleum or veneer in different finishes. Bevelled edge. Tabletop edge matches frame finish. 1 mm laminate / 2 mm linoleum.

FRAME / Slanted wooden legs featuring non-visible integrated screw-in adjustable feet that can be extended up to 12 mm to make the table level on uneven surfaces.

COLOUR & FINISH

Please note that the colour codes are indicative.

TABLETOP / Available in 8 different tabletop finishes.

- / Black linoleum (Forbo Nero 4023)
- / Green linoleum (Forbo Conifer 4174)
- / Grey linoleum (Forbo Ash 4132)
- / Off white linoleum (Forbo Mushroom 4176)
- / White laminate (Formica F3091)
- / Black water-based lacquered oak veneer
- / Water-based lacquered oak veneer

FRAME / Available in 4 different frame finishes.

- / Black water-based lacquered solid oak (RAL 9005)
- / Water-based lacquered solid oak
- / Soaped solid oak

CONSTRUCTION

A wooden support bar with steel reinforcement is pre-mounted under the tabletop. The legs must be mounted with self-tapping screws in predrilled holes in the tabletop.

Requires assembly.

RECYLING AND DISASSEMBLY

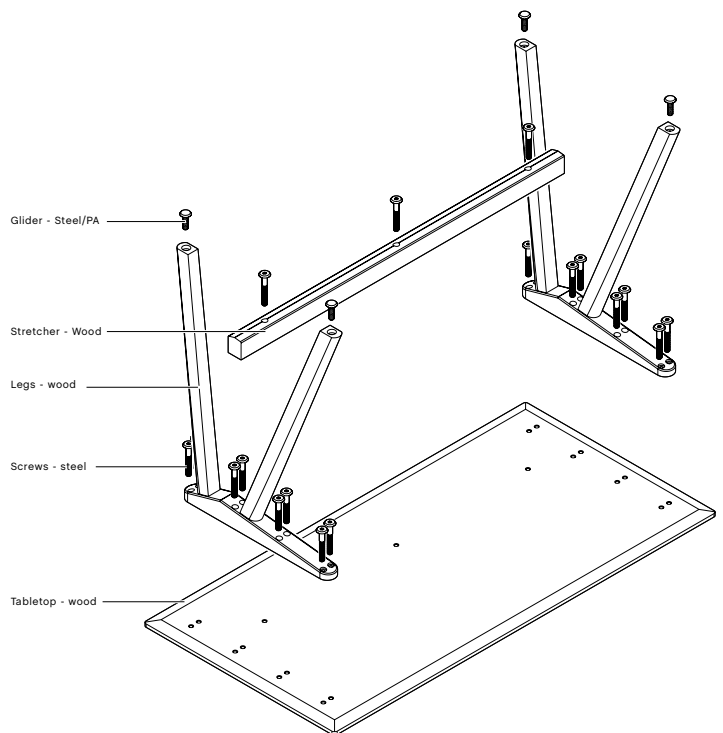
CPH 90 is designed to be a long-lasting furniture made to last for many years. The table is 100% recyclable and all parts can be fully separated and recycled. All parts can be delivered to a suitable recycling facility.

To disassemble the table, turn it over and unscrew all screws holding the legs and stretcher. Lastly unscrew the gilders from the legs.

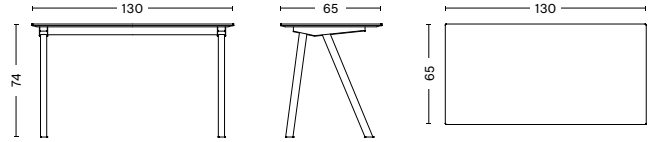
