The Costes sideboard, conceived by Tosca Design studio, is rich in details yet at the same time reproduces a **plain and minimalist aesthetic**. The curved transparent glass sides are interspersed with vertical metal inserts, which give rhythm to the composition and allow a glimpse of the internal glass shelves. In addition, LED lights inside the sideboard enhance its precious details and quality materials, shaped with care and precision. But the real detail that differentiates it is the **refined feet**, composed of two metal elements forming a Y that rests gracefully on the ground.

The wooden doors, made of diagonal wooden planks, highlight the fascinating grains of the natural wood, available in Canaletto walnut or burned oak. The Costes sideboard naturally adapts to any space in the house. It is conceived in three models: the 2 doors high version, the 3 doors lower one, and the TV cabinet. Costes style is refined and balanced, it perfectly expresses the **high quality and finely selected details**, which are typical of Italian manufacturing.

On one hand the internal shelves in smoked glass have a storing function, on the other hand, their purpose is to showcase one's most cherished objects.

Finishes

Canaletto walnut or burned oak.

Base in titanium and bronze embossed lacquered steel.

Metal details in bronze embossed lacquered steel and internal fumé glass shelves.
